





INTRODUCTION


HERITAGE

The Château of Couches, also known as Marguerite de Bourgogne's Château, is listed as a French historical monument. This fortress, which once separated the Kingdom of France from the Duchy of Burgundy, occupies a large quadrilateral still surrounded by ramparts.

Built from the 11th century and altered in the 15th and 19th centuries, the Château continues to undergo numerous restorations today to maintain its architectural heritage and ensure its preservation for many centuries to come. In this spirit, the Château underwent a spectacular transformation in 2019 with the meticulous renovation of the roof structure and the glazed Burgundy-tile roof of the main residence.






VISITS AND WINE TOURISM



VISITING THE CHÂTEAU




Built from the 11th century, the Château still has its tower of justice, keep, chapel, underground passages and main living quarters (which are not open to visitors). Guided tours, audio-guides or self-guided tours, a variety of options allow you to discover the Château in the way that suits you best.

TASTING OUR WINES








ATMOSPHERE


GASTRONOMY




THE SETTING




THE ROOMS

Rooms No. 2 and No. 3 can be joined to form a family suite, giving access to a sitting room for reading or sharing a drink.





As part of the Château's heritage preservation efforts and to welcome a greater number of guests, the romantic manor house near the pond will soon undergo a complete renovation.





THE CHATEAU'S CELLAR

Located in Saint-Sernin-du-Plain, the Cave de Mazenay produces its own Burgundy wines, including the Château's wines. With determination and expertise, it promotes the Côtes du Couchois' PDO nationally and internationally. Although based in the heart of this appellation, the winery's approach is not limited to this single PDO; it also includes the production of a full range of Burgundy wines stretching from the Côtes de Nuits to the Côtes Chalonnaises, and of course the Côtes de Beaune.


THE HOSPICES DE BEAUNE

In the year of our Lord 1443, in a context of great misery and famine, Nicolas Rolin (chancellor to the Duke of Burgundy) and his wife Guigone de Salins founded the Hôtel-Dieu of Beaune to help the poor and the sick. The hospital was financed by monetary donations, land, buildings and ... vineyards.

Today, more than 60 hectares of vines, notably in the Côte de Beaune and Côte de Nuits, are cultivated to be vinified and sold at this illustrious auction. Each year the Cave de Mazenay acquires a few fine bottles to age and offer for sale, contributing to this noble charitable endeavour.

THE “CLOS DU CHÂTEAU”




Within the Chateau itself, in a thousand-year-old enclosed plot, discover Burgundy's three emblematic grape varieties. On this soil steeped in history, Aligoté, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir offer the best of themselves, benefiting from the particular nature of the granite.

Saline notes and minerality for the whites; finesse and an explosion of red fruit for the Pinots Noir, a generous contribution from a complex, very old soil locally known as the “cran”.

It should be noted that the entire production is aged in oak barrels in traditional Burgundy 228-litre casks.


THE “CLOS DU CHÂTEAU” - THE EXCEPTION



With exactly ten “ouvrées” of Pinot planted (42.8 ares) the red wine parcel enjoys a perfect location, both in terms of slope and orientation. When the vintage allows, one third of the production undergoes extended ageing for 24 months, adding further complexity to the “A la folie” cuvée.

BLASON DE VAIR - SINGLE-VINEYARD CUVÉES




Emblem of the lords of Couches between the 12th and 15th centuries, the Blason de Vair is an interlacing of silver squirrel tails.

Blason de Vair is also the name reserved for the estate's single-vineyard cuvée, which cover 26 hectares and half a dozen very different soil types (sandstone, blue marls, sandy clays ...). These soils give each wine batch its own personality.

“Sous le Clos”, “Les Baumes”, Le “Bois de Bouhy”, “Les Fulletières”, taste the soils through the wines.



The Château's main seminar room stands beneath the chapel's roof structure.

With its exposed beams and historic architecture, this space offers an intimate, elegant setting for a work meeting, conference or workshop.


INTERIOR SPACES

Entirely renovated in 2016 after nineteen months of meticulous restoration, this space has preserved the Château's historic soul while integrating contemporary fittings.

The beams, dating from the 15th century, were carefully restored and complemented by chestnut beams from Autun.




WELCOME


AN UNUSUAL COCKTAIL


CORPORATE SEMINARS **OUTDOOR**

THE ROOFTOP


HEAD IN THE CLOUDS




PRIVATE EVENTS
